Course Description

The economic problem derives from the combination of two fundamental facts: resources are finite while our demands for them are essentially infinite. Hence, the study of economics deals with the question of how to allocate these scarce resources given technology at both the national and individual level.

The focus of macroeconomics is on the operation of the national economy. Therefore, this course involves an examination of the economic problems of economic growth, unemployment, and inflation. In addition, the effect of both fiscal and monetary policies on these major problems will be explored.

The course will explore the fundamental economic principles and frameworks that will provide a basis for understanding how the economic world works. The Problems and Applications assignments and Tests will focus on practicing and demonstrating your understanding of these fundamental principles and frameworks. These basics, however, tend to be very sterile, giving the perception that if all worked according to plan, issues of economic inequality or discrimination would disappear over time. We know, however, that these issues persist, rather than fade. Through the Discussion Board assignments, we will explore sources of disfunction in the economic theory, environment, and system that lead to persistent and pervasive economic inequality and discrimination. I will ask you to read and listen to a variety of experts and consider your own experience as we add this layer on top of the basic theory presented in the course. In addition, the Group Project asks you to apply the theory and frameworks we study in class to develop and demonstrate your understanding of these basics and to evaluate how the issues we consider in the

Discussion Board assignments influence your analysis of the economic performance of the country your group chooses.

Course Objectives

By the end of this course, you will be able to:

1. Define and explain measures of macro-economic performance.
2. Identify sources of long-run growth. Explain connection to improvements in standard of living and persistent economic inequality.
3. Define different types of unemployment and explain causes. Explain why zero unemployment is not the goal.
4. Explain the causes and real costs of inflation.
5. Explain causes and consequences of short-run fluctuations in the economy.
6. Define monetary and fiscal policy and explain their pros and cons and how each affects the economy in the long-run and the short-run.

1. ASSESSMENTS AND GRADING

Tests (40% of grade) – There are 5 tests scheduled for this course. All tests will be administered via Canvas comprising a timed online test. Of the 5 tests, I will drop the lowest score and the remaining 4 will be worth 40% of your grade. Tests will be available in Canvas for one week per the course

schedule. As such, there will be no makeup tests. If you have extra-time accommodation approved through Disability Access Services, you must provide me with a current professor notification letter (PNL), and I will adjust your test environment accordingly. If you have such accommodation, I strongly suggest you take advantage of it. Experience has shown that students who do not use their allowed extra time struggle with the test portion of the course to the detriment of their grade.

Homework (20% of grade) – Homework will be assigned through the MindTap system for every chapter covered during the term. Late assignments will be accepted for up to 4 days after the due date/time at a 10% penalty. After that time, assignments will receive a score of zero. I will drop the 3 lowest homework scores (including zeros for any homework not completed).

Macroeconomic Performance Analysis Project (20% of grade) – Each student will participate in a small group (2 people) analysis of a specific element of a country's macroeconomic performance – Labor Force Utilization, Inflation, Savings and Investment, or Business Cycles. Due dates for the project vary by topic as we cover each in class, see Canvas for specific topic dates. Groups will be available for sign-up in Canvas through September 30. On October 1, I will assign groups for anyone who has not yet signed up. Details available in Canvas.

Discussion Board Assignments (20% of grade) – There will be a series of discussion board assignments that will require you to read/listen to presentations about issues related to the course material being covered at the time. You will be provided with prompts to stimulate discussion about the topic. You will be expected to post your own thoughtful response to the prompts and the media and reply directly to two other student posts. Details for each discussion are in Canvas.
